4) Disposition of comments

Apostolos Syropoulos, Xanthi, Greece (2009-06-15):

Partially accepted. The concern has been recognized and the wording will be clarified. In principle, the polytonic Greek issue should be handled in line with MES-2.

Albrecht Dreiheller, Siemens AG (2009-06-18):

Accepted. This issue is purely editorial, was caused by the implementation of the transformation into PDF and has been fixed.

Evgeniya Zhegova, Bulgarian Institute for Standardization (2009-08-18):

1. Not accepted. "Informative references" is the correct title in the context of a CWA.
2. Partially accepted. Annex 2 should be retained but its position and wording reconsidered.

Alain LaBonté (2009-09-02):

Noted. Revised text will be provided for SC35 work both in the body of the document and in the annex.
