1) Opening the meeting

The workshop will aim at extending the keyboard functionality without creating additional deviation from the international standard. The workshop's main concern is the variety of Latin characters. Yves Neuville stated 98% of keyboards in the world are compliant to the 9995 standard. He also pointed out the problems with electronic wiring and the scan codes of keyboards.

5) Introduction of the Project Team and distribution of tasks

The Project Team consists of Troy Korjuslommi, Karl Pentzlin, Michael Pluke and Maria Stambolieva. Erkki Kolehmainen has written the introductory draft and other members have also contributed, including Karl Pentzlin, Jukka Korpela and Bernd Kappenberg. The contributions serve as background material. The forthcoming tasks remain to be distributed. Maria Stambolieva offered to submit considerations concerning the Bulgarian issues. Karl Pentzlin will continue his ongoing work.
